### **2010 Songs at Six Concert Series Set for Thursdays in July**

*1<sup>st</sup> Officially Scheduled Longwell Parking Deck Concert to be Held on July 8th*

(Westminister, MD) – Summer is here! Get out and enjoy it! One way is to catch the free *2010 Songs at Six* Concert Series in Downtown Westminister.

Great musical sounds will emanate from the Locust Lane stage every Thursday at 6:00 pm, except July 8<sup>th</sup> (more on that later), during the month of July, as the *Songs at Six* Concert Series comes back to rock the town.

**Aspen Run** will kick off the series on Thursday, July 1<sup>st</sup>. **Aspen Run** is an amazing 6-man bluegrass band that performs hard-driving bluegrass. The band cites Flatts & Scruggs, The Stanley Brothers, Bill Monroe and Jimmy Martin as musical influences.

Due to a scheduling conflict, the July 8<sup>th</sup> *Songs at Six* concert will be held at a different venue than Locust Lane Stage. The band **Twenty Dollar Prophet** will have the honor of performing the 1<sup>st</sup> officially scheduled concert in the Longwell Parking Deck. This concert will give a new meaning to the term “garage band.” The Longwell Parking Deck has been serving as the rain venue location for the *Lunch on the Lane* and *Songs at Six* Concert Series since last year. **Twenty Dollar Prophet** is a classic/alternative rock band that calls Westminister home.

*Songs at Six* returns to the Locust Lane Stage on July 15<sup>th</sup> with the **Greg Gottlieb Project**. Featuring local singer/songwriter Greg Gottlieb and Eddie Healy from Fairfax, VA, the Project will be jammin’ out favorites from Bob Marley to Neil Diamond and everything in between! Be prepared to participate in the music-making, as Greg has a tendency to pass out percussive “toys” to the audience.

The popular **Roach Brothers** of Taneytown, MD bring their classic rock styling to the Locust Lane Stage on Thursday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**The Tony Scuito Band** closes out the series on July 29<sup>th</sup>. Playing and writing music since the age of 12, front man Tony Scuito played with Australia’s *Little River Band* from 1990-1997. You can also catch him performing on re-runs of the TV show *Full House*, as part of John Stamos’ band - *Jessie and The Rippers*. The band is making a return visit to the Locust Lane Stage, having previously performed here as part of the 2008 *Lunch on the Lane* Concert Series.

Before the July 29<sup>th</sup> concert, come find out who the winners of Downtown Westminster's *Paint the Town Purple* Summer Storefront Decorating Contest will be, as the awards will be announced that evening from the stage.

Each concert runs from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm, so come downtown early and have dinner in your favorite restaurant or buy a slice of pizza and a sandwich from one of our downtown take-outs, and come listen to the music while you savor our local flavors.

Locust Lane Stage is just off East Main Street, across from the Westminster branch of the Carroll Public Library, between Pomeroy Jewelers and The Optical Solution. The Longwell Park Deck concert venue will be on the lower level of the parking deck near the corner of Locust Lane and Winters Street, across the lane from Paradiso Carry-out.
