Welcome!

The Westminster Municipal Pool aims to serve the recreational needs of the residents of Westminster and the surrounding area. The Pool opens on Monday, May 28 and remains open through Monday, September 3. **Hours are 12 noon to 7pm daily. However, when Carroll County Public Schools are open the pool will remain closed.**

Admittance is by membership or daily gate fee. The Pool has a separate wading pool, playground, sand volleyball court, 6ft waterslide and concession stand, recently upgraded playground equipment and NEOS 360.

Water aerobics is offered on Tuesday & Thursday evenings in August only from 6-7 p.m. Pool and fitness center members may participate for free and the general public is welcome for a \$2 walk-in fee at the gate.

Pool Rules

The following rules are for the protection and benefit of all to assure safe and sanitary operation of the Pool facilities. Your cooperation in abiding by these rules will afford a pleasant recreation facility for all. Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules and obey the instruction of all employees. Your cooperation is not only appreciated but necessary to insure a safe and enjoyable facility for all.

1. All persons using the Pool or Pool grounds do so at their own risk and are solely responsible for any accidents or injury in connection with such use. Persons using the Pool, covenant and agree with the City for or on account of any injury (a membership agreement form must be completed and on file).
2. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at least 18 years of age and must remain with the child the entire time they are at the Pool. All guests must have a signed waiver form on file. If the guest is under 18 waiver must be signed by parent or legal guardian.
3. The city will not be responsible for any loss or damage of personal property of any kind.
4. The cost of any property damage will be charged to responsible party.
5. Pool membership cards are not transferable. Membership cards will not be issued without current photo on file.
6. Membership cards must be shown in order to enter Pool grounds. A \$5 fee will be charged to replace lost cards.
7. All guests must have their hands stamped to leave and reenter the Pool grounds.
8. Admission will be denied to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections or wearing bandages.
9. Appropriate swimwear is required for all swimmers, No cutoffs or thong suits allowed.
10. Children age 3 and under must wear rubber pants or swim diapers at all times. Failure to abide by this policy may result in removal from the premises.
11. Only persons passing the deep-water test prescribed by the Pool Manager will be permitted in the deep-water end of the pool.
12. Flotation devices such as tubes, boards, swimmies and life jackets are strictly prohibited unless U. S. Coast Guard approved.
13. Running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing or any undo disturbances in or around the Pool will not be tolerated and could result in removal from the premises and suspension of privileges.
14. The lifeguard has the right to sit out anyone not obeying Pool rules for an appropriate period of time. The manager has the authority to suspend Pool privileges for up to one week. The City reserves the right to revoke season or daily guest pass of anyone who repeatedly violates Pool rules.
15. Adult swim will be announced by the Lifeguard every hour for the enjoyment of persons over the age of 18. Children will not be permitted in the Pool during this time.
16. Smoking is not permitted. All City facilities are smoke free. Smoking is permitted in designated areas only– not at the gate or on the steps. Extinguish materials before entering Pool.
17. Alcohol is strictly prohibited!
18. No glassware of any type permitted on the Pool Grounds. Coolers will be subject to inspection by staff.
19. Pets are prohibited on Pool Grounds.
20. Chewing gum is not allowed in Pool area.
21. All food and refreshments must be consumed in the concession area only.
22. Trash must be deposited in proper receptacles.
23. Wheeled vehicles (bikes, skateboards, rollerblades, etc.) are prohibited in Pool area.
24. Profanity or abusive language will not be tolerated.
25. Use of Pool lawn chairs is for everyone on a first-come, first-served basis. No reserving chairs for others. Personal lawn chairs may be brought into the Pool area.
26. First aid supplies are available at the Guard Station.
27. In order to be courteous to others, radios and TV's will be strictly prohibited inside the Pool fence.
28. The Carroll County Health Department maintains strict guidelines pertaining to fecal accidents. In the event of a fecal accident the Pool will be required to close for an amount of time deemed reasonable by the Carroll County Health Department. Cash refunds will not be issued in the event of a fecal accident.
29. These rules may be revised or amended at any time at the sole discretion of the City.
30. Failure to comply with any of these Rules will result in the violator being barred from use of Westminster Municipal Pool facilities.
