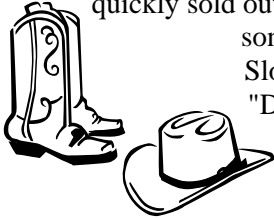
July 4th, 2010 – Sound Storm

July 11, 2010-Dean Crawford and the Dunn's River Band

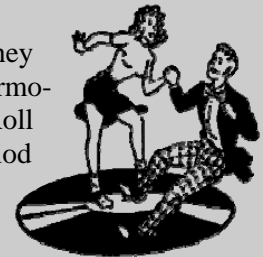
Without a doubt, **Dean Crawford and the mighty Dunn's River Band**, have emerged as the Mid-Atlantic's premier Country/Southern Rock group. Led by Jamaican born-and-raised **Dean Crawford**, **Dunn's River** has been entertaining the Mid Atlantic's hard core Country fans for more than 10 years. The author of more than 400 songs, **Dean Crawford's** first self-published CD of six original songs, "Hang on Tight" debuted December 2003 and quickly sold out within two months. His second CD, "Red Blooded American Boy" with 13 original songs, debuted July 2004 and has surpassed 7,000 in sales thus far.
